

KBS CUP RULES 2010

- 1) All players must be a member of the club they are representing.
- 2) Any players who appear on the lists of open finalists will be ineligible for the tournament. The opens used for reference were Carrigaline, Bandon, Bishopstown, Rushbrooke, and Sundays Well.
- 3) In the event of a club entering more than one team, the players may not swap between teams; a substitute may sub for one team only.
- 4) If a club fields an ineligible player, the club shall forfeit that players matches.
- 5) A team will consist of 2 boys & 2 girls. Players must have been 15 or under on the 31st of December 2009.
- 6) Matches will consist of 1 Boys Singles, 1 Girls Singles & 1 Mixed Doubles.
- 7) Each match will be the best of three tie-break sets.
- 8) In the event of a tie between teams at the conclusion of the group stage, the teams will be separated by a) the result of the match between the tied teams, b) least sets conceded in all matches, c) if necessary a play-off.
- 9) There are 2 groups for a total of 8 teams. The top team in each group will qualify for the final.
- 10) The home team must contact the away team at least 5 days in advance of fixture.
- 11) Matches are to be played on or before the date given on the fixture sheet. If teams can't agree on a time, they must play at 12 o'clock on the date given on the fixture sheet.
- 12) Match sheets should be fully completed in case a count-back is necessary. One point is awarded per game won within that match and three points are up for grabs in each match. Please clearly mark the final score on the results sheet before sending back.
- 13) Score sheets to be returned by the HOME team.
- 14) All appeals should be made to Ken Murphy (087-2369888) within 48 hours of match.
- 15) Extensions will only be granted due to extremely bad weather; under all circumstances you should contact the tournament organisers.
- 16) The final will be played in Carrigaline Tennis Club on Saturday, May 22nd.
